



State Route 95 Pavement Project: Courtwright Road to Bullhead Parkway

Project Cost: \$26 million

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation will begin a construction project this summer to replace the riding surface along a 23-mile section of State Route 95. The pavement project is between Courtwright Road in Mohave Valley and the Bullhead Parkway in Mohave County (mileposts 227-250).

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Removing the top layer of pavement and replacing it with new asphalt.
- ▶ Replacing curb and gutter, sidewalk ramps, pavement markings and other related work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Lane restrictions will be limited to overnight hours only and will not be in place during the day or weekends. Business access will be maintained throughout construction.

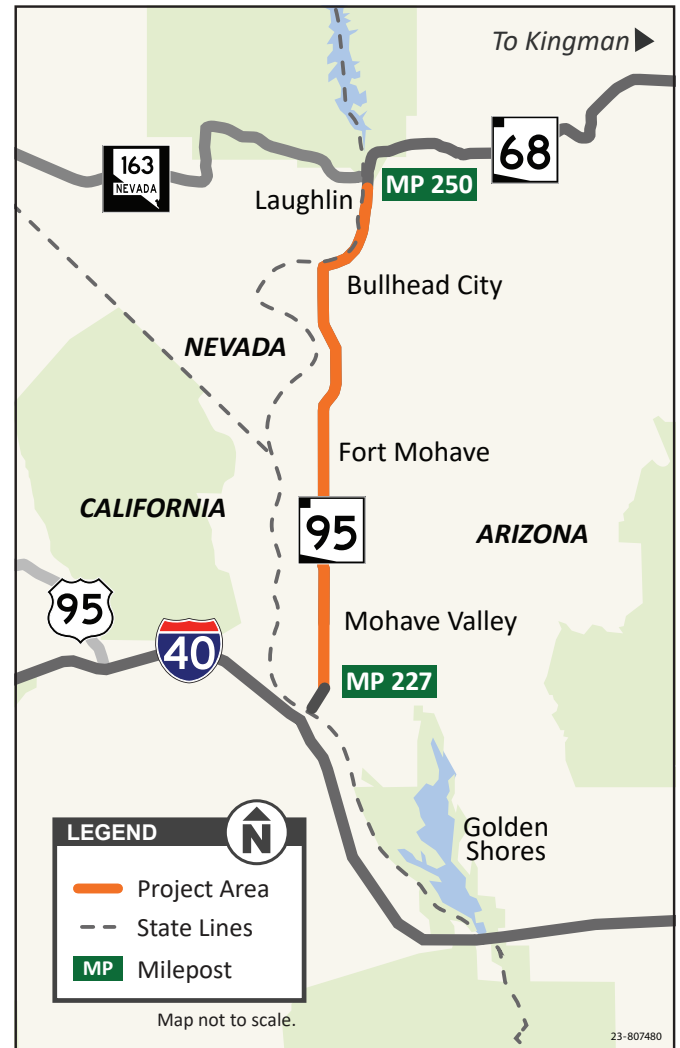
ADOT reminds drivers to proceed through the work zone with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment while the following restrictions are in place:

Overnight intermittent lane restrictions on north- and southbound SR 95 from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday evenings through Friday mornings.

- ▶ Drivers should be prepared for delays up to 15 minutes.
- ▶ One lane will remain open in each direction.
- ▶ The speed limit will be reduced in the work zones.

Construction is scheduled to begin this summer and be completed in summer 2024.

Schedules are subject to change because of weather or other unforeseen factors. ADOT will post information about traffic restrictions and closures as it becomes available.
