## SR 87 Coyote Wash Bridge BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Navajo Nation, has initiated a bridge replacement project at the Coyote Wash Bridge (milepost 375) along State Route 87. The bridge is located between Winslow and Second Mesa in northeastern Arizona. Work will include replacing the existing bridge superstructure, installing erosion prevention elements under the bridge, guardrail replacement, pavement marking replacement and other related work.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

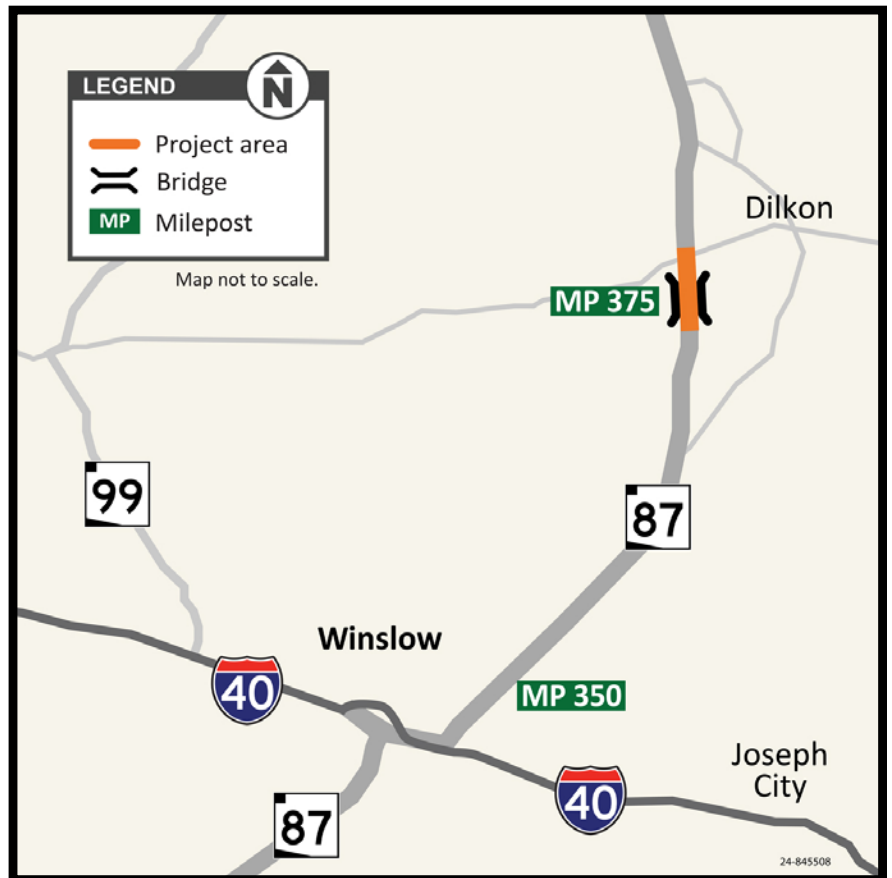
SR 87 will be narrowed to one lane only with alternating north- and southbound travel beginning in mid-April 2024 and continuing through the end of the year.

Traffic will be controlled by a temporary traffic-control signal.

Drivers need to be prepared to slow down and stop in the work zone and use caution around construction personnel and equipment while the restrictions are in place.
