



# State Route 90: Border Patrol Station to Moson Rd.

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is completing pavement rehabilitation located in Cochise County on SR 90 between mileposts 304 and 325, from the Border Patrol Station to Moson Rd.



## WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ One lane will be open to traffic in both directions for the majority of the project and drivers should anticipate delays. Please allow for extra time when traveling through the area. More information will be available closer to the start of construction.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.

## PROJECT SCHEDULE

- ▶ Construction is scheduled to begin in winter 2023/2024 and is expected to be completed Summer of 2025.

## PROJECT ELEMENTS

The project includes the following elements:

- ▶ Rehabilitating pavement
- ▶ Replacing guard rails
- ▶ Installing new sidewalks, sidewalk ramps, and signage
- ▶ Replacing existing asphalt with new asphalt
- ▶ Completing new pavement markings
- ▶ Installing in ground-in rumble strips on shoulders and center line as necessary
