



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a project to improve the pavement condition along State Route 69 between Truwood Drive and Stoneridge Drive (mileposts 287-290) in Prescott Valley. The project will address the deterioration of the road and extend the service life of the existing pavement on the highway.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- A minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open along SR 69 during paving operations beginning in spring 2023 and continuing through fall 2023.
- To reduce traffic impacts, all work will take place overnight from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday evenings through Friday mornings.
- Access to businesses will be maintained while work is underway.
- Drivers should be prepared for restrictions at various intersections as paving work progresses and use alternate routes.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

This project includes the following elements:

- Removing and replacing the top layer of pavement on north- and southbound lanes.
- Repairing damaged sidewalk and updating sidewalk ramps and landings.
- Restriping pavement markings.
