

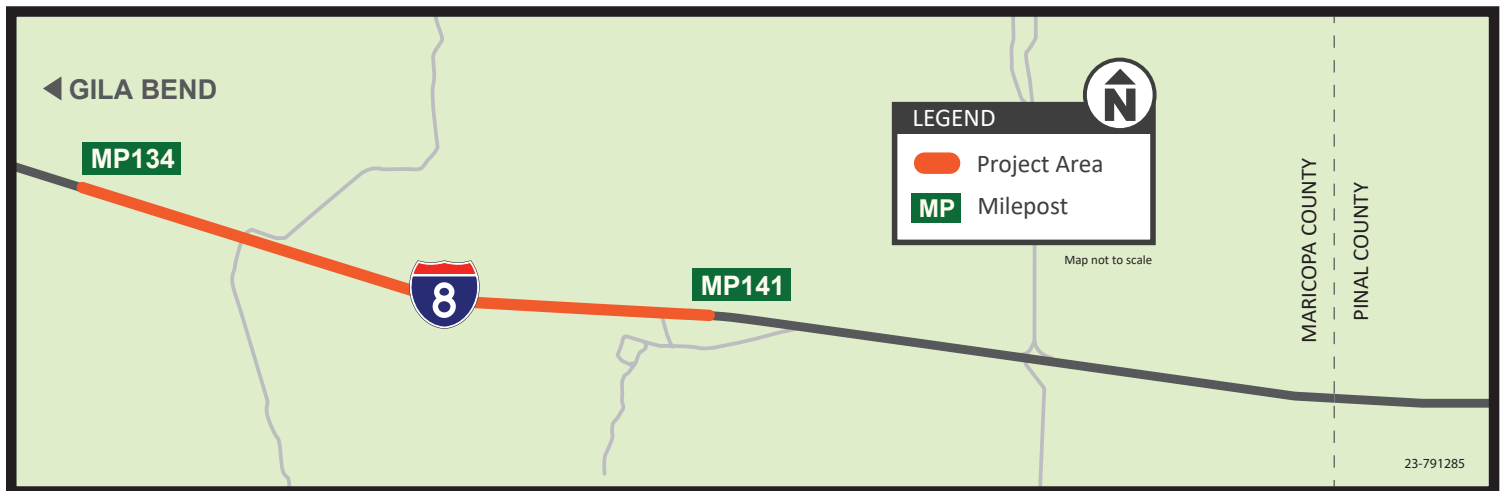


# Interstate 8: between milepost 135 and 141 pavement preservation

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration are initiating a project to maintain pavement and improve safety on Interstate 8 between mileposts 135 and 141, west of the Pinal county line.



### PROJECT ELEMENTS

- ▶ Removing and replacing existing pavement
- ▶ Minor bridge rehabilitation
- ▶ Remove and replace cattle guards, guard rails, and spillways
- ▶ Bridge railing will be replaced with concrete barriers
- ▶ Building up the shoulder of the road and pipe relining
- ▶ Replacing pavement markings and other related work

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin late spring 2023 with completion anticipated in spring 2024.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

Expect delays as lane restrictions on I-8 will be necessary. Work is scheduled to occur weekdays from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Drivers are asked to obey posted speed limits and traffic control devices and use caution around construction personnel and

equipment. Schedules are subject to change based on weather and other unforeseen factors.

ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
