US 95, Aberdeen Road to Castle Dome Mine Road PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is repairing the pavement on US 95 between Aberdeen Road (milepost 47) and Castle Dome Mine Road (milepost 54), north of Yuma. The work consists of removing the existing pavement surface and replacing it with new asphalt concrete.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Replacing guardrail
- Repairing a bridge deck and replacing a bridge barrier
- Replace military tank crossing
- Replacing pavement markings
- Test vehicle crossing improvements
- Storm drainage improvements

PROJECT SCHEDULE

The project is scheduled to begin late summer 2024 with expected completion late winter 2024. Schedules are subject to change because of weather and other unforeseen situations.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work is scheduled to occur from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on weekdays.
- Drivers are asked to use caution, obey posted speed limits and traffic control devices and use caution around construction personnel and equipment.
- ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.
