

Overdimensional Permit Council Subcommittee

DRAFT Meeting Minutes October 20, 2010

The Overdimensional Permit Council Subcommittee met on October 20, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. at the Arizona Trucking Association (ATA), 7500 W. Madison St., Tolleson AZ 85353, Subcommittee Chairman Michael Monfred presiding.

Call to Order:

A quorum being present, Chairman Monfred called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

1. Roll Call:

Tina Zismann conducted a roll call of the council

2. Introductions:

Chairman Monfred welcomed the public, public officials, members of the Overdimensional Permit Council Subcommittee and staff to the meeting.

3. Call to the Public:

4. Update on Title 17 Rulemaking

The subcommittee reviewed and informally discussed and suggested language to A.A.C. Title 17, Chapter 6, /Articles 1-5 relating to Overdimensional Permits.

MVD offered to look into the following matters:

- R17-6-101B -The definition for “Envelope” be changed from 4 axels to 3 axels given that there isn’t a difference if the 3 axels uses a counterweight
- R17-6-101B- The definition “Specified load” verbiage be changed from “exact dimensions” to verbiage similar to “within the limits”
- T17-6-102.C- Adopt a dual lane formula or some formula that will allow loads like transformers to move in the state
- R.17-6-104.C.1- Evaluate changing “identical” to verbiage such as “within route”

- R17-6-204.C.4- Evaluate that if MVD were to add the requirement for extra power units that it be included into Table 4
- R17-6-204.C.5- Provide current managements vision regarding MVD weighing of loads
- R17-6-307.A- Wording is confusing and evaluate rewrite
- R17-6-401.A.1- Evaluate the existing language that allows trucks to operate for 30 minutes before sunrise/after sunset as it is still light enough outside to operate safely remain in the rule and not be changed
- R17-6-401.A.2- Discuss a possible compromise regarding lanes that OD loads are limited to
- R17-6-411 was last rule to be discussed, rest of rule will be discussed at a future meeting

Chairman Monfred recommended the Overdimensional Permit Council Subcommittee not meet until Industry has reviewed remaining portion of the proposed rule.
