



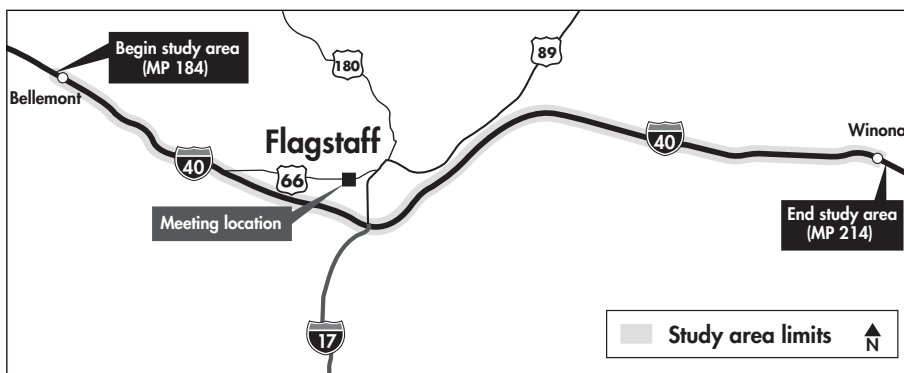
# **PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), as the lead federal agency, have initiated a study to evaluate alternatives to provide added capacity and improve traffic operations on Interstate 40 (I-40) from the Bellemont Traffic Interchange (TI) to the Winona TI. The study area extends along I-40 from mileposts 184 to 214 in Coconino County, Arizona. Proposed alternatives may involve widening I-40, expanding and/or adding traffic interchanges, or maintaining the existing I-40 highway (no build alternative). The build alternatives would likely require new right-of-way.

ADOT and FHWA invite you to attend a public scoping meeting for this study. Scoping is the period during the initial portion of the study when the public is given the opportunity to learn about the study and identify issues to be addressed. The purpose of the meeting is to provide an overview of the study, discuss the environmental and engineering processes and schedule, and provide the opportunity for members of the community to ask questions and provide input. A brief presentation on the study will be made at the meeting, followed by an open house where representatives from the study team will be present to answer questions.
