Public meetings scheduled for study of SR 260 from Heber to Show Low

SHOW LOW – The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) will host two public meetings on its study of potential improvements to State Route 260 between Heber and Show Low.

The meetings are scheduled as follows:

The meetings will in an open house format to provide opportunity for attendees to view maps and graphics and speak to study team members. There will be a 15-minute presentation beginning at 6:30 p.m.

The study examines alternatives to improve traffic flow on SR 260 between Heber and Show Low. Alternatives, such as constructing additional lanes and consolidating access points are being evaluated for potential environmental, social, and economic impacts.

The purpose of the meeting is to update the public on the status of the study as well as gather public input. The comments received from the meetings will be used to help identify critical issues to be addressed in the development and evaluation of the alternatives and help identify a preferred alternative to be examined in further detail.
