Greenway Road and Loop 303

Temporary Intersection Re-Alignment: December 9-12, 2011

Loop 303 Improvement Project (Mountain View Boulevard to Peoria Avenue)

Beginning in December 2011 and continuing for approximately 10 months, the intersection of Greenway Road and Loop 303 in Surprise will be in a temporary, re-aligned configuration so crews can safely build the new Greenway Road overpass while minimizing impacts to traffic.

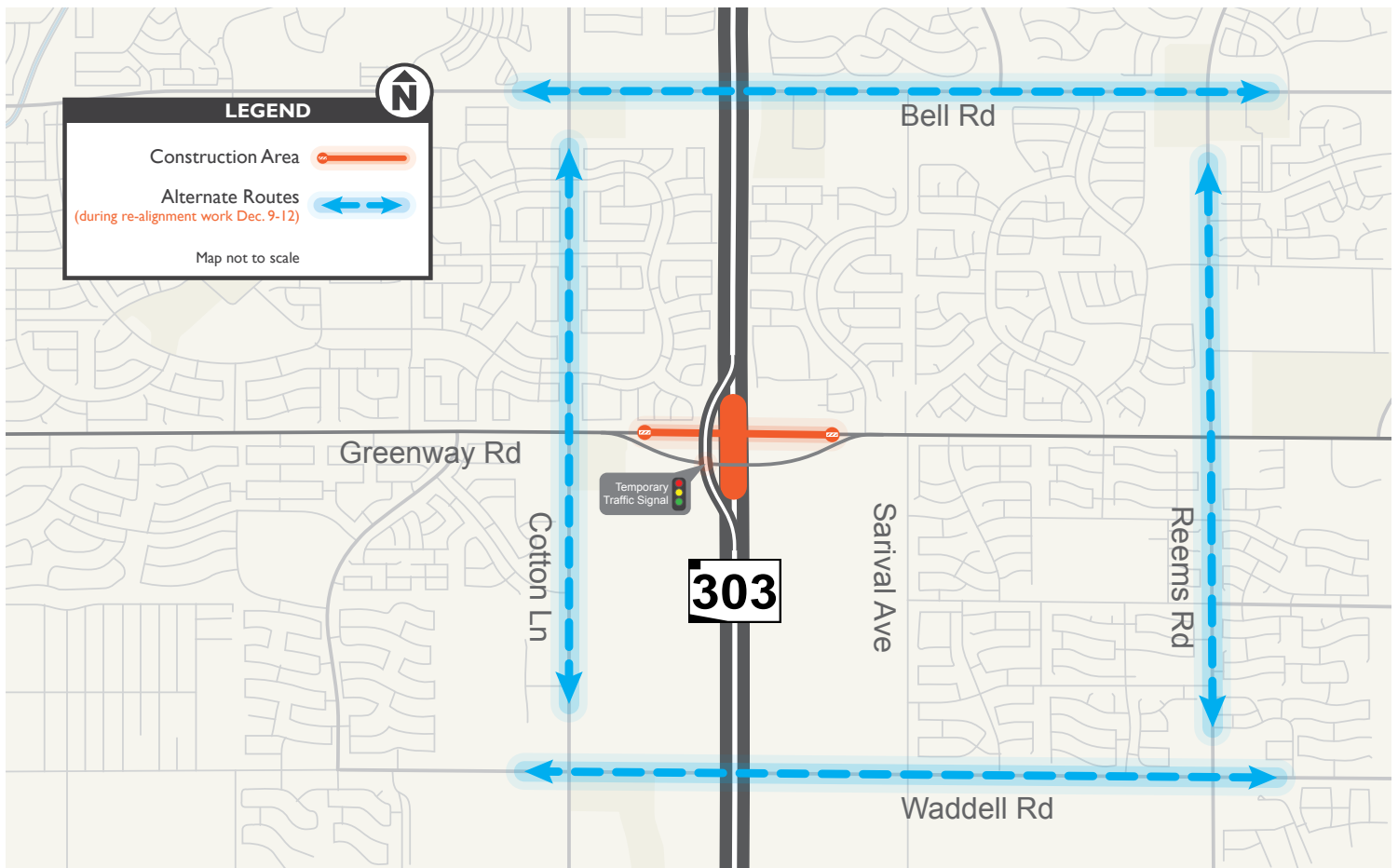
During construction of the Greenway Road overpass, the intersection will be re-aligned to the south approximately 200 feet and to the west approximately 150 feet, and a temporary traffic signal will be installed. Homes and businesses will remain accessible and a temporary sidewalk will be in place. Work to re-align the intersection into the temporary configuration will occur Dec. 9-12, 2011. The intersection will remain in the re-aligned configuration through fall 2012 while construction of the Greenway Road overpass is underway.

WORK SCHEDULE

Work to re-align the intersection into the temporary configuration is scheduled for **10 p.m. Friday (Dec. 9) to 5 a.m. Monday (Dec. 12)**. During this time, the following restrictions will be in place:

- ▶ **East-** and westbound Greenway Road will be closed between Cotton Lane and Sarival Avenue (access to Greenway Road businesses will be maintained).
DETOUR: Use Waddell or Bell roads.
- ▶ **North-** and southbound Loop 303 will be closed between Waddell and Bell roads.
DETOUR: Use Reems Road.

These restrictions will be lifted, and motorists will begin using the newly realigned intersection, by 5 a.m. Monday (Dec. 12).
