



LOOP 202 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

(Red Mountain Freeway)

Eastbound Frontage Road Closed

BETWEEN 42ND STREET AND 44TH STREET

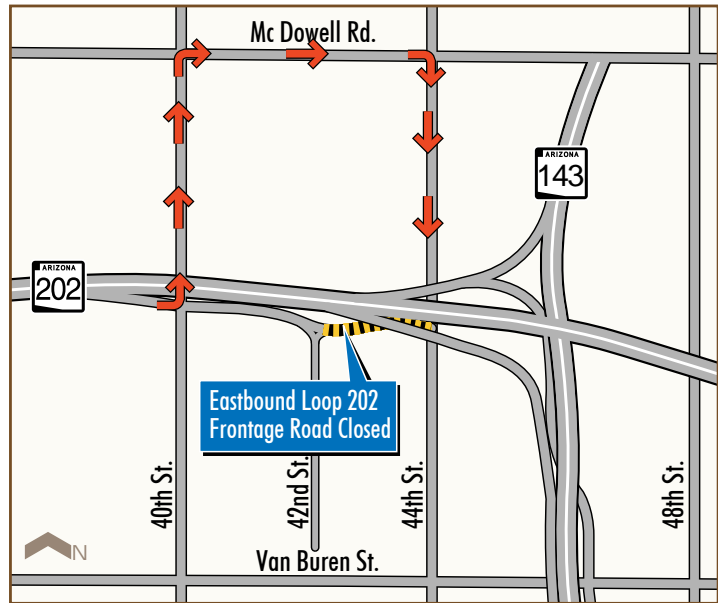
October 4 – November 16

Beginning at 9 p.m. Sunday, October 4 through 5 a.m. Monday, November 16 the eastbound frontage road between 42nd Street and 44th Street will be closed and drivers will be detoured due to the ongoing Loop 202 freeway widening project.

Vehicles will be restricted from accessing 44th Street from eastbound Loop 202 on the frontage road between 42nd Street and 44th Street, and will be detoured to McDowell Road. Vehicles can access 44th Street from 40th Street by traveling northbound on 40th Street and eastbound on McDowell Road to 44th Street.

* *During night times hours, noise is expected to occur due to construction activity along the frontage between 42nd Street and 44th Street.*

** *Please note: Access will be maintained to residences and businesses at 42nd Street.*



PROJECT SUMMARY

As a component of the voter-approved Maricopa Association of Governments' Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) has begun a roadway widening project on the Loop 202 (Red Mountain Freeway). This widening project will result in additional eastbound lanes on the Loop 202 between SR 51 (Piestewa Freeway) and Loop 101 (Price Freeway), and additional westbound lanes between Loop 101 and Scottsdale/Rural Road within the Cities of Phoenix and Tempe.

WORK ZONE SAFETY

Safety is a vital part of the ongoing construction process. It is important to plan ahead for restrictions and to slow down in the work zone. Drivers and pedestrians are responsible for staying alert and obeying traffic laws; including signage, traffic barricades and flaggers within construction work zones. **Most importantly: slow down in the work zones.**

As with any complex construction project, there is a possibility that severe weather or other unforeseen difficulties may result in unscheduled closures, restrictions, or delays.
