Re: 2009 SEAGO TIP Amendment #2

Enclosed is a copy of the 2009-2013 SouthEastern Arizona Governments Organization's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), amendment #2. This 2009 TIP #2 was approved and recommended for consideration to the Executive Board for approval by the SEAGO TAC on March 19, 2009 at their regularly scheduled TAC meeting. This TIP was also approved by SEAGO's Administrative Council on April 2, 2009 and SEAGO's Executive Board, in a special meeting held April 4, 2009.

TIP amendment #2 includes the ranked and fiscally constrained ARRA road construction projects in year 2009, as well as the ARRA proposed Enhancement projects.

Santa Cruz County has asked SEAGO to put their Palo Parado project on the TIP in order to apply for, or receive funding from an alternative federal funding stream. Until the project is on the TIP (and STIP) it will not qualify for funding. The funding stream for this project is local, until such time they received other funding.

The meeting dates and times where the TIP was discussed are included below for your information. The SEAGO TIP is a standing agenda item for all SEAGO TAC, Administrative Council, and Executive Board meetings. I have listed all the meetings where this TIP #2 was discussed, and action was taken.
