As the Governor's designee, I approve the action taken by the Western Arizona Council of Governments (WACOG) Executive Board June 16, 2009, to amend their FY 2009-2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include a revised list of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) construction projects and Transportation Enhancement projects utilizing ARRA funds for FY 2009. I cordially request Amendment Number 32 to the FY 2009-2012 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the attached list of modifications.

WACOG ARRA Project List

The Western Arizona Council of Governments has developed an ARRA Transportation Project List for La Paz and Mohave Counties. Recently ADOT informed me I needed to make a minor change in the project list to reflect only 100% funded projects. Previously Lake Havasu City had listed 2 different signals for funding even though funds were not sufficient to construct 100% of both signals. WACOG then contacted Lake Havasu City and asked for which signal they would advance for construction using ARRA funding. South Palo Verde and Acoma intersection was selected and funded at 100% of the funds remaining available (\$364,687). The second intersection, Smoketree and Acoma remained in the program with \$0 funds allocated to the project. This will then allow for any unused funds from any of the projects, be set aside toward the unfunded signal, and should LHC desire to supplement additional funding to finish the cost of the second signal, could be completed without an additional TIP amendment.

WACOG 5Yr Transportation Program FY 2009-2013

The Western Arizona Council of Governments each year develops a construction schedule of approved local Transportation Enhancement Projects. This year WACOG received additional funding through ARRA to fund the Lake Havasu Pathway along Pima Wash and Mohave County received ARRA funds for the first phase of Mohave Wash. Following several meetings it was determined ADOT had overlooked funding the second phase of the pathway which also is bid ready with all clearances obtained. The Transportation Enhancement Review Committee chose to add \$440,000 of additional ARRA funding to the second and final segment of the pathway from Banks Street to Northern, and to reflect this project in the current construction year 2009. The change in the construction program reflects the 2nd Mohave Wash Pathway for Mohave County being added to the program.
