

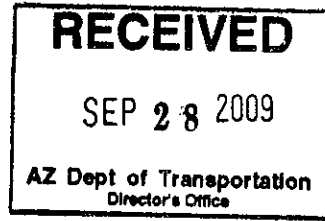


Dear Mr. Halikowski:


