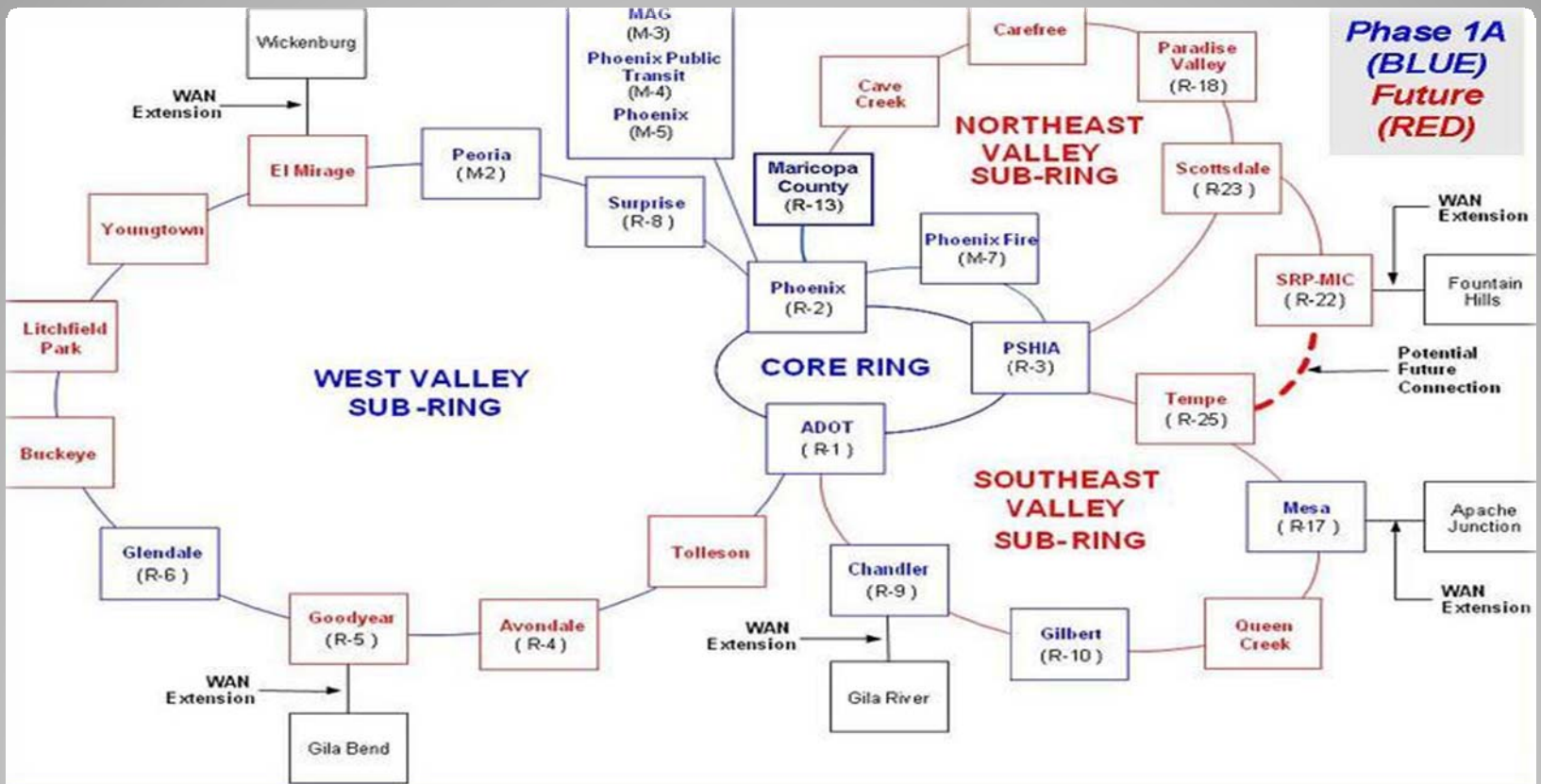

PROJECT SAFETY: Utilize proper training, the use of safe equipment and procedures, conduct weekly safety meetings and regular site inspections, closely adhere to the contractor safety plan and contract requirements resulting in zero construction or public-related accidents.

ENVIRONMENTAL/REGULATORY AWARENESS: Ensure compliance with all environmental/regulatory agency requirements and follow proper reporting procedures for all environmental issues.

FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY: Be good stewards of the public's funds and return a fair contractor profit by building it right the first time, minimizing change orders, being timely in determination of pay quantities and payment for work performed and in processing change orders.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: Make a concerted effort to remain in close contact with potentially impacted community and business factions and keep the traveling public and emergency responders informed so that the overall impact of the project is minimized.
