Drainage Improvements Begin On US 191 Lower Coronado Trail

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) will begin drainage improvements on U.S. 191 on the Lower Coronado Trail from milepost 173 to milepost 182, on Oct. 19. The \$320,555 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act project includes culvert extensions, new pipe-culvert installations, new embankment curb, drainage ditch improvements and new down drains to improve drainage in the area.

Construction will occur weekly, Monday through Thursday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Drivers can anticipate reduced speeds through the construction zone and lane restrictions, with one lane of traffic remaining open. Motorists may experience occasional delays of up to five minutes through the construction zone. The project is scheduled to be completed in mid-December 2009.
