### San Pedro Proposed Bridge Replacement

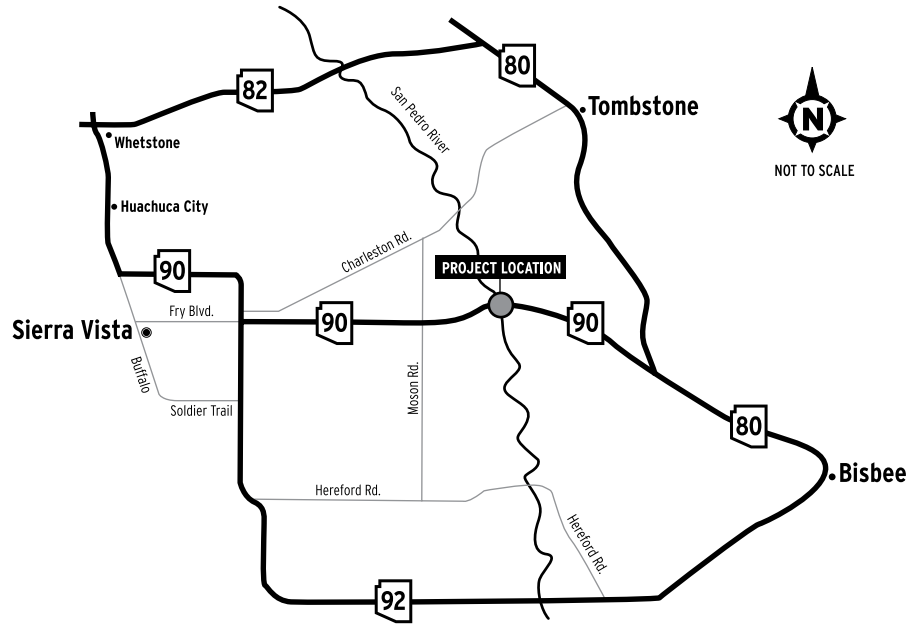

## PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) invite the public to attend an informational meeting on the replacement of the State Route (SR) 90 San Pedro Bridge. The purpose of the meeting is to gather ideas, comments, questions and concerns from the public. Representatives from the project team will be present to answer your questions and address your concerns.

The bridge is located on SR 90 in the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area, which is home to two endangered species, the Southwestern Willow Flycatcher and the Huachuca Water Umbel, and a primary location for thousands of migratory birds each year. With the restrictions on the construction work and schedule due to the endangered species and their habitats, two options for replacement of the bridge will be presented at 6 p.m. during the meeting.



The current information on the proposed bridge improvements includes:

- Budget for San Pedro Bridge replacement is \$4.6 million.
- Full replacement of the SR 90 San Pedro Bridge will result in widening the bridge from 26-feet wide to 44-feet wide.
- Bridge would include two 12-foot-wide travel lanes, and a 10-foot-wide shoulder on each side.
- Improved roadway approaches.
- Rubberized asphalt will be used for the pavement.
- Roadway construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in October 2011.
