Arizona Department of Transportation Interstate 40 Holy Moses Wash to Rattlesnake Wash Pavement Preservation Project

Project Description

The Arizona Department of Transportation is conducting a pavement preservation project on Interstate 40 (I-40) between Holy Moses Wash and Rattlesnake Wash. Improvements include the removal and replacement of asphalt on I-40 between Holy Moses Wash and Rattlesnake Wash, as well as the West Kingman, East Kingman, and Stockton Hill traffic interchanges, installation of traffic sensors and upgraded guardrails, replacement of pavement markers, and installation of rumble strips on shoulders.

ADOT uses pavement preservation as a cost-effective method to extend the life of the roadway and repair the road surface for smoother driving conditions. I-40 is an essential component of Arizona's highway network. These improvements will not only extend the life of the pavement surface, but will also facilitate the efficient movement of goods and services through Kingman.

24 Hour Work Schedule to Begin Oct. 11

Crews began work on eastbound I-40 just east of exit 53, Andy Devine Avenue, on Monday, September 28. In an effort to expedite the improvement project, beginning Sunday, Oct. 11 at 10 p.m. crews will begin to work 24 hours a day, Monday through Thursday, and between midnight and 2 p.m. on Fridays.

Lane Restrictions

Lane restrictions are required on both eastbound and westbound lanes to allow for a safe work zone for both motorists and crew members. These lane restrictions will move along with crews as they progress. Crews are expected to begin work on the westbound right lane the week of October 5. Traffic control will remain in place 24 hours a day, Monday through Friday. Expect brief delays when approaching areas with lane

restrictions.

Stay Informed

ADOT strives to keep the public informed about construction projects, lane restrictions, and closures. This eUpdate is distributed periodically to help keep the Kingman community informed.

Please note: Changes to construction plans can happen frequently due to weather, equipment availability and personnel issues. We try to anticipate construction activities a week in advance but changes may occur. Intermittent lane closures, with short delays, may not always be known in advance.
