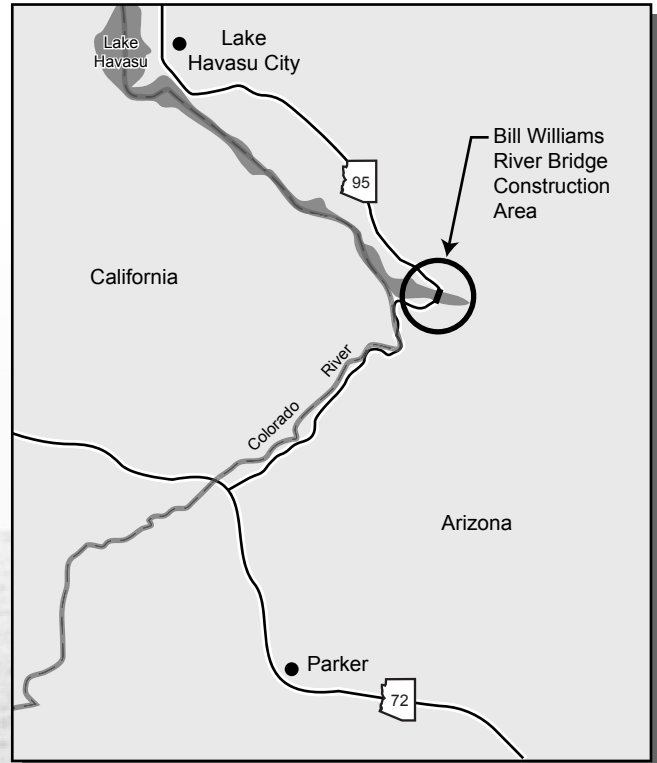




SR 95 Bill Williams Bridge Repair Notice of Construction

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) announces that improvements to the Bill Williams River Bridge, located between the town of Parker and Lake Havasu City on State Route (SR) 95, are under way. The project is scheduled for completion by mid-February 2010.

Currently, the project team is working to repair damage caused by a tanker truck accident. The work includes renovating the bridge deck, cleaning and waterproofing the underside of the bridge, and replacing some sections of the barrier to extend its service life.



What to Expect

Work will take place daily between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. with the exception of the weekends. Work is not being conducted on the weekends to minimize the impact on traffic. Bridge traffic will be restricted to one-lane for the duration of the project. Traffic barriers and portable traffic signals will be in place to allow for a safe work zone for motorists and construction work crews.
