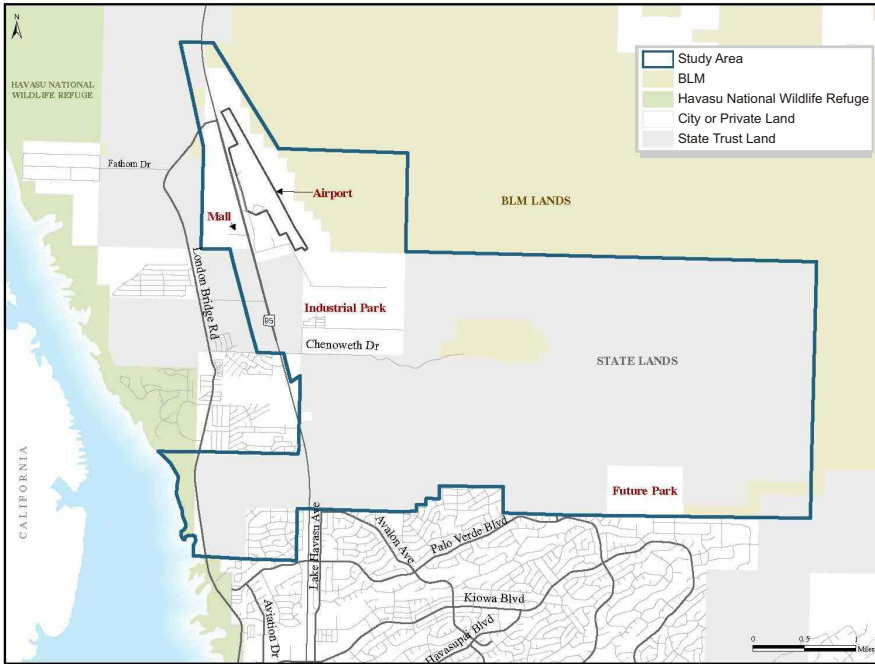




North Havasu Area Transportation Study

Study Area



Study Background

The North Havasu Area is anticipated to experience development in the near future as the Lake Havasu City metropolitan area continues to grow. This area does not yet have a street system, except for the existing State Route (SR) 95 and a short section of Chenoweth Drive.

This study provides an opportunity to proactively address the transportation needs of this area as it develops, such as how to connect the area to the city street system, existing SR 95, and the potential realignment of SR 95. The study also provides an opportunity to further strengthen the local public transit system.

The study will assist the Lake Havasu City government in planning and prioritizing the various needs of the community and the transportation system in the study area. Your input will be a vital part of this study.

About PARA

The Planning Assistance for Rural Areas (PARA) program provides federal funds to non-metropolitan communities for the purpose of conducting transportation planning studies. PARA funds may be applied to address a broad range of planning issues related to roadway and non-motorized transportation modes.

Lake Havasu City is using this funding to support development of a Transportation Plan to address transportation issues and improvements to accommodate future growth. Your contribution is a vital part of identifying transportation issues important to Lake Havasu City.

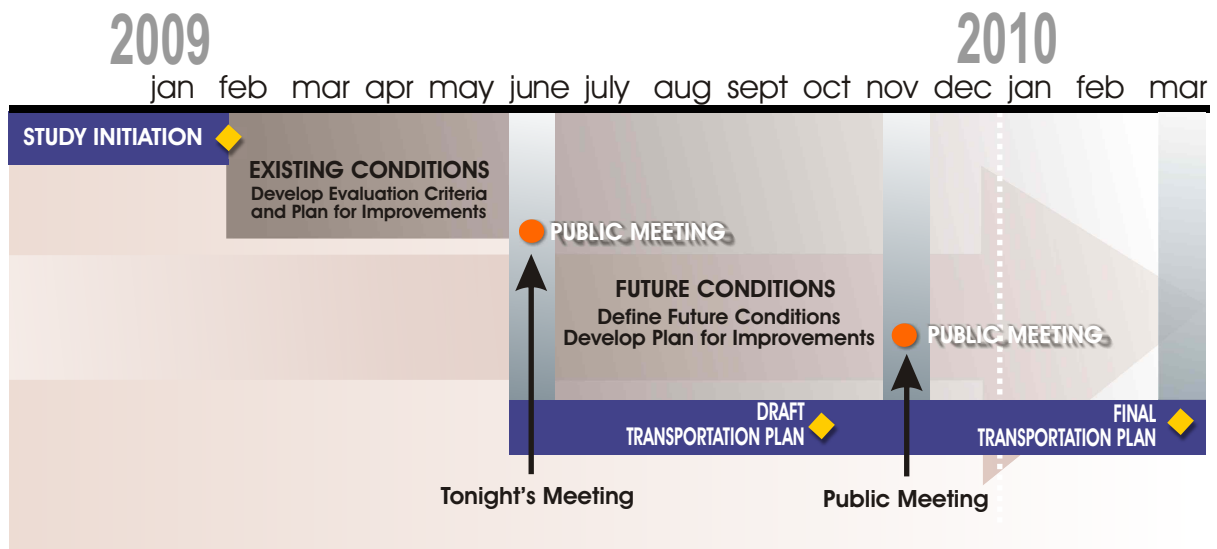
Meeting Purpose

Tonight's public meeting is the first of two public meetings planned for this study. Tonight we will introduce the study, present current transportation conditions in the study area, and obtain feedback from meeting participants. By combining tonight's findings as well as results from stakeholder interviews, technical advisory committee meetings and transportation analysis, a Draft Transportation Plan will be developed. A second public meeting will be held in the fall of 2009 to update the public on the status of the study and to share the preliminary findings. The North Havasu Area Transportation Plan will be finalized in the Spring of 2010.
