Planning Assistance for Rural Areas (PARA) is a program sponsored by ADOT's Multimodal Planning Division that provide funding for communities to conduct planning studies.

### What is Multimodal Transportation?

Multimodal transportation is a combination of different modes of transportation such as buses, automobiles, bicyclists, and pedestrians in one complete system. Providing alternatives for transportation can reduce congestion, improve the environment, and promote a healthy lifestyle.

### The Kingman Area Transportation Study Update

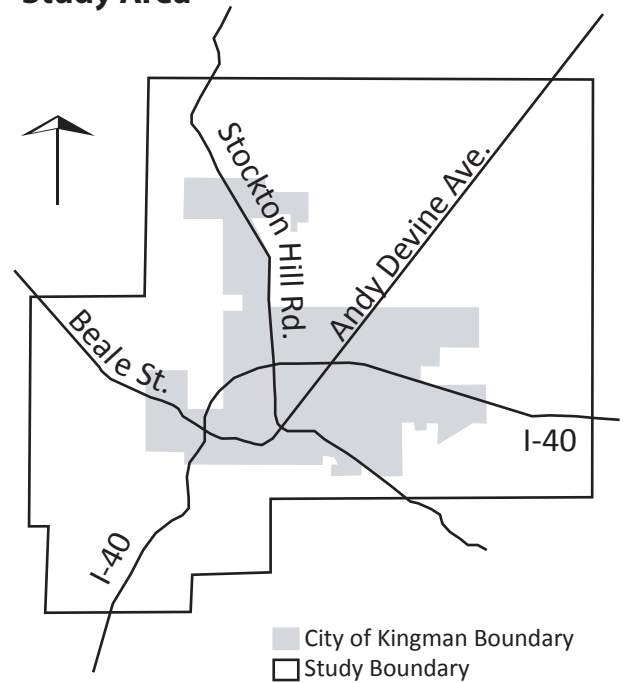
The Arizona Department of Transportation is working together with the City of Kingman to update the 2005 Kingman Area Transportation Study. This study is part of ADOT's **PARA** program which will produce a plan recommending transportation improvements for the next 5, 10, and 20 years. The recommendations will be **multimodal**, which takes into consideration roadways, non-motorized transportation (bicycles and pedestrians), and transit components (buses and rail).

Over the next few months, the study team will look at data regarding the existing transportation system, conduct Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) meetings, and gather input from the public and stakeholders to identify the needs of the Kingman area. Once this information has been collected and analyzed, the project team will present their findings to the public and stakeholders. The complete study schedule can be found on the reverse side of this handout.

ADOT and the City are asking for your thoughts regarding transportation needs in your community. How would you like to move throughout the area (bike, walk, drive, ride, etc.)? 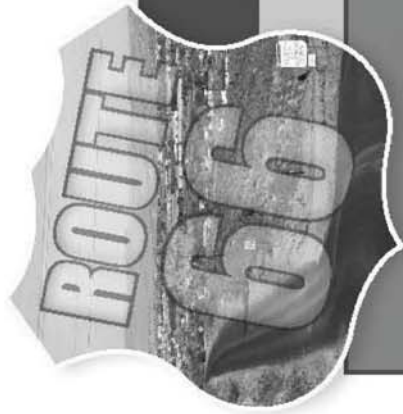
