The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), in cooperation with the Town of Payson, is conducting a transportation planning study for the greater Payson area. The principal focus of the proposed study is to develop a long-range transportation plan for the town. The plan will address growing demands placed on local roads and streets as a result of significant population growth, economic development, and increased traffic volumes. In addition, this growth and development calls for an examination of public transportation, bicycle, and pedestrian needs and opportunities. The major product of the study will be a plan for improvements over five- and ten-year periods, and a long-range transportation plan (20 year horizon) incorporating roadway, public transportation, and non-motorized elements.

The September 2nd public open house will be held to present current and projected transportation conditions and issues. The Town of Payson and ADOT encourage area citizens and other stakeholders to attend this meeting to voice their concerns and ideas regarding the transportation issues facing the town of Payson.
