



US 60: East Salome Wash Bridges

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a \$1.9 million construction project in La Paz County to improve two bridges on US 60 near Salome (milepost 57-59).



PROJECT ELEMENTS

The project includes the following elements:

- ▶ Constructing concrete floors underneath the existing bridges to improve the bridge foundation.

- ▶ Replacing the existing bridge railings with new bridge barriers.
- ▶ Installing new guardrails.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- ▶ US 60 will be periodically reduced to one lane only at the bridges, with flaggers directing alternating east- and westbound traffic through the work zone.
- ▶ Drivers should be prepared to stop when approaching and passing through the work zone and use caution around construction personnel and equipment while the restrictions are in place.
- ▶ ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions to email subscribers (see “Stay Informed” below) and on the project web page.
